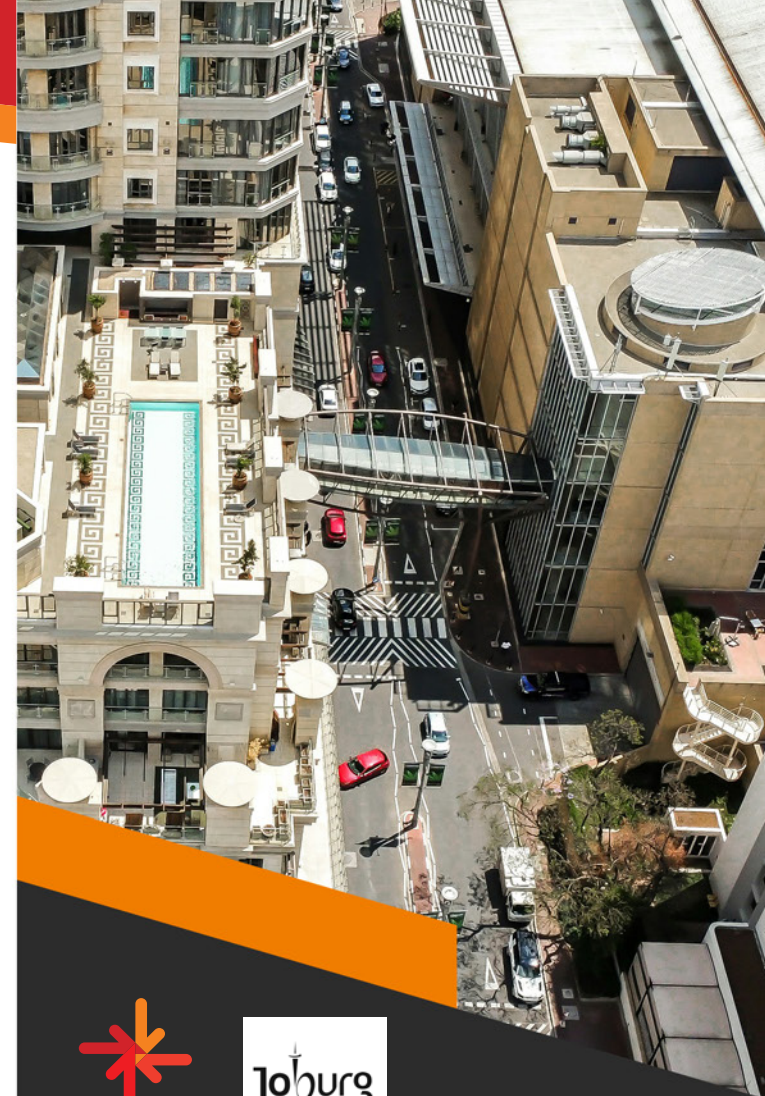

Stash before you dash

- Don't leave valuables in your vehicle in full view of passers-by.
- If you need to leave your belongings in your vehicle, be vigilant when putting them in your cubby-hole or boot.
- Preferably, lock valuable items in the boot before you start your trip.



Hold tight, out of sight

- Don't walk with your cell phone in your hand, keep it out of sight.
- If you need to use your cell phone, step into a nearby shop, restaurant or building foyer.
- Don't flash your jewellery, especially gold chains and watches, to avoid jewellery snatching.
- Hold your handbag tightly and ensure it is zipped up or closed.
- Don't leave your wallet or cell phone unattended on a restaurant table.

Lock & check before your trek

- Don't fall prey to remote jamming, a technique used to interfere with your vehicle's locking system.
- Always lock your vehicle's doors and manually check them before you walk away.
- Stay vigilant when approaching and leaving your vehicle.



Be wise, stay safe

- You DON'T NEED a permit to walk in Sandton Central. If you are asked to buy a permit, you are being scammed.
- Don't hand over your bank card or punch in your PIN into any handheld keypad (like a calculator) or building entrance keypad. It's a scam!
- Don't let a stranger lead/accompany you to an ATM for any reason.
- If you need to draw money, ensure that no one can see your PIN.
- Don't allow anyone to distract you at the ATM.

Stay safe - help is at hand

Sandton Central is monitored 24/7 by CCTV surveillance cameras, employs a team of 36 safety ambassadors and is backed up by 3 tactical vehicles manned by 6 tactical personnel. The cleaning team, comprising 26 members, works daily from 06h00 to 17h00, focusing on crime prevention, cleaning, maintenance, and landscaping, seven days a week
